SYLLABUS

Course topics

The course focuses on the analysis of a business enterprise across different disciplines, views and approaches. The PhD students will develop *case histories*, exploring the following topics: business strategy, organizational model and practices, policies of human resources management, methods and practices of product and process innovation, business model, model and practices for management control, financial and accounting analysis.

Aims

The main aims of the course are to provide students with:

- the basic tools needed to design a case history;
- the ability to plan and use appropriate methods to undertake a case history;
- the ability to critically and autonomously interpret a case study articles on the basis of their research design.;
- allow students to analyse a firm in a multidisciplinary view;
- understand the advantages, challenges, and limitations of case study research

Class Discussion; project work.

Final Test

A “case history” work based on: participant/non participant observation, semi-structured interviews, document analysis
