

The Library is located on the second floor of the ancient Convent of Santa Maria delle Dame Monache, on the banks of the Volturno. In the nineteenth century, the convent was transformed into a barracks of the Bourbon army named after Ettore Fieramosca. Today the complex is returned to the production of knowledge and higher education.

Services for users

Registration is required to use the Library's services. Each user is assigned a "user code" that allows them to access the services of consultation, loan, reservation of a text and reservation of a place in the Library.

Reference

The Library provides a reception, information and orientation service for bibliographic research, the use of the University catalogue and databases. The online reference service is available at: uff.biblio.economia@unicampania.it

Consultation

Consultation is allowed only inside the reading room. The search for bibliographic material and periodicals must be carried out by connecting to the University's online catalogue (Sebina Opac), it is possible to use the library's PC workstations.

Loan

The loan service can be accessed by professors, researchers, doctoral students, subject experts, students and technical-administrative staff of the Department of Economics, users of the University and external users. The loan of bibliographic material has a duration of 15 days and can be renewed only if the text has not already been booked by another user.

Intersystemic loan

Intersystemic loan makes it possible to find volumes owned by the other University libraries on a reciprocal basis.

Document Delivery

Document Delivery (DD) is a service for the supply of documents within the limits imposed by current legislation on copyright (Law no. 633 of 22/04/1941 and subsequent amendments). The library adheres to NILDE (Network Interlibrary Document Exchange), a cooperative system that allows you to request/provide documents respectively to external libraries and to internal users of the library.

Essper

The Library is a member of ESSPER. ESSPER is a group of more than 150 Libraries and Documentation Centres associated to provide innovative services in the field of documentation of economic, social sciences, law and history. It aims to improve the usability of the documentary heritage by offering the community of students and researchers a database of periodicals that includes over 850 Italian titles. The ESSPER database is accessible free of charge by any user. The search in ESSPER produces the retrieval of the bibliographic information relating to the article found, as well as the connection of the same to the indications of the Libraries that own the periodical.

Databases and electronic resources

Databases are organized collections of information for different subject areas.

This important bibliographic service is particularly useful for researchers, for professors, scholarship holders, doctoral students and thesis students. The <u>electronic resources</u> can be consulted through the use of the University <u>wi-fi</u> network and also outside the University network with the Proxy system of the Libraries or with access to the IDEM federation, managed by GARR. You can search and browse electronic resources through the Discovery tool <u>EDS: Ebsco Discovery Service</u>.

The list of databases is periodically updated on <u>the library's website</u>. For credentials and further information, please contact the library.

Sensus access

Sensus access was created for users with special needs and responds to the guidelines for the right to education of pupils and students with specific learning disabilities. It is an inclusive technology solution that allows the immediate conversion of documents into an accessible format thanks to an automated process.
